Once again, there will be two components to our Design Awards. We want to see some fabulous designs from our small firms.

The first component, and new addition is a photo exhibition of your photos of your projects. These photos must be taken from a smart phone or Ipad (or something similar) - No photo shop allowed. Images are limited to a square format. Submissions must be emailed to [michellemarks@ls3p.com](mailto:michellemarks@ls3p.com) by, at a minimum, the name of the project, the name of the member submitting the image, and the name of their firm. **Submissions are due September 8, 2017.** The photos will be printed and displayed at the Design Awards Ceremony being held on September 21, 2017 at Thalian Hall.

The second component is our traditional Design Awards display at our annual lecture to be held Thursday, September 21, 2017 at Thalian Hall. For our traditional design competition, Entry Fee is \$50.00 per submission. **The submission deadline is Thursday, August 17, 2017.** Entries may be built or un-built. The projects must be designed by members of AIA Wilmington. The projects may be located anywhere. Built projects must have been completed in the last 5 years.

- Any digital images (up to 12 images 8x11 inches at 300dpi)
